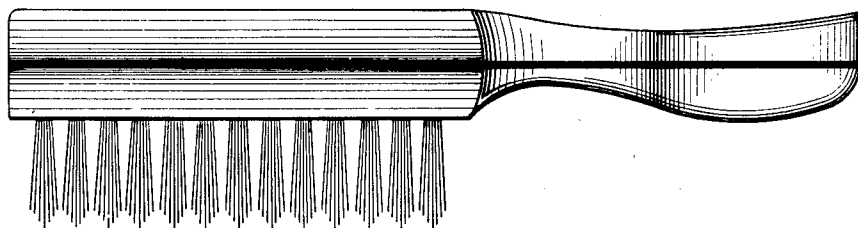

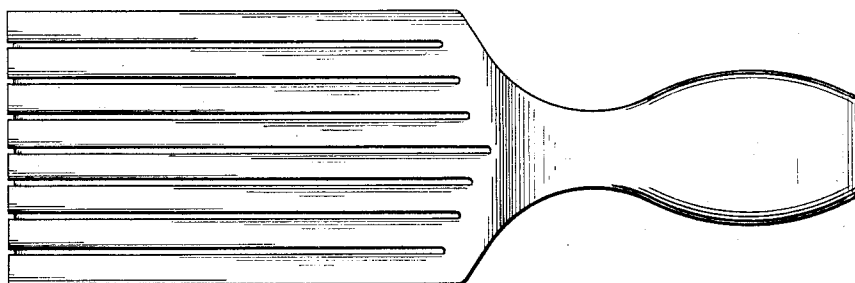

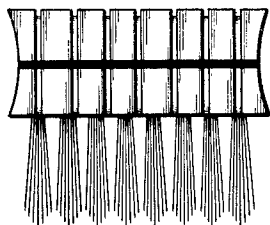
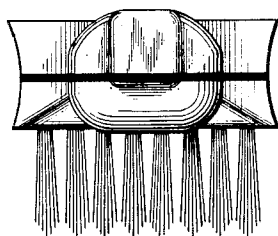

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harold M. Schwartz, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Brush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which—

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a brush embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the brush shown in Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is an end view of the brush as viewed from the left in Fig. 1, and

Fig. 4 is an end elevation of the brush as viewed from the right in Fig. 1.
