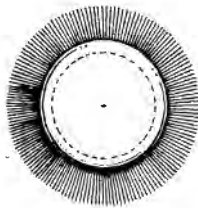

DESIGN FOR A LATHER BRUSH OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.
