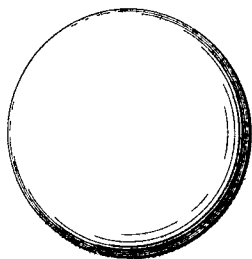

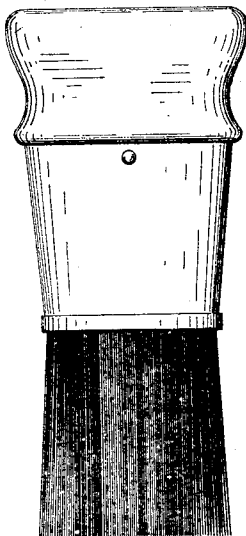

DESIGN FOR A STENCIL BRUSH

Application filed November 22, 1930. Serial No. 37,755. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS B. DENTON, a citizen of the United States, residing at #122 North Walnut Street, East Orange, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Stencil Brush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
